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**RESOLUTION NO. 2025-9-22-001**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A 2025 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) FOR THE TOWN OF WAMSUTTER ON BEHALF OF THE GOVERNING BODY FOR THE TOWN OF WAMSUTTER, SWEETWATER COUNTY, WYOMING.**

**WHEREAS**, the Wyoming Community Development Authority ("WCDA") offers the WCDA Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") which is a federally funded program designed to assist county and municipal governments with activities directed toward neighborhood revitalization, housing opportunities, economic development and improved public facilities and services; and

**WHEREAS**, WCDA distributes funds annually through a competitive statewide application process, and said applications are scored and ranked against one another; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of the Town of Wamsutter recognizes the Wamsutter community needs to construct a second water tower to accommodate maintenance of its current system and the water needs of its citizenry, and upgrades to Quealy Park to become compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Wamsutter has been awarded grants in the past for the water tower projects and Quealy Park projects as part of programs designed to assist municipal governments with activities directed toward neighborhood revitalization, economic development and improved public facilities and services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of Town of Wamsutter met in its regularly scheduled meeting on September 15, 2025, at 6:00 p.m. local time, and discussed the options and viability of the Town submitting a WCDA CDBG application; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of Town of Wamsutter believes that submittal of an application to the WCDA for a CDBG is in the best interests of its citizens and the most economically viable option to secure funding for the construction of a second water tower to accommodate maintenance of its current system and the water needs of its citizenry, and upgrades to Quealy Park to become compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of the Town of Wamsutter understands that the WCDA CDBG grant application requires certain standards be met, as described in the application as provided by WCDA; and

**WHEREAS**, to the best of the Governing Body of Town of Wamsutter's knowledge, the Town of Wamsutter has met the requisite criteria set forth in the CDBG application; and

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**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of Town of Wamsutter has completed the CDBG application and plans to submit the same for consideration by WCDA.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE Town of Wamsutter, SWEETWATER COUNTY, WYOMING that:**

- 1) A grant proposal and application be submitted to the WCDA Community Development Block Grant in the amount of **ONE MILLION NINE HUNDRED FIFTY-EIGHT THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$1,958,450.00)** for the construction of a second water tower to serve Wamsutter's water needs;
- 2) A grant proposal and application be submitted to the WCDA Community Development Block Grant in the amount of **SIX HUNDRED EIGHTY-FOUR THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$684,250)** for the Quealy Park project for the Town of Wamsutter;
- 3) This Resolution and the actions prescribed herein shall become effective upon the execution hereof.


